COMMUNITY

Convене ERP/DXP's community provides features available to users that have a registered account and are logged into the system.

Benefits of Convене include:

- Site visitors may register for an account and create a profile.
- Creating an account provides access to additional community features.
- Community features include:
 - Viewing the community stream.
 - Viewing community pages, events, topics, albums, and groups.
 - Viewing community members.
 - Creating events, topics, albums, and groups.
 - Registering for community events.
 - Participating in community topics.
 - Messaging community members.
 - Following community members.
 - Liking, commenting, and reporting posts.

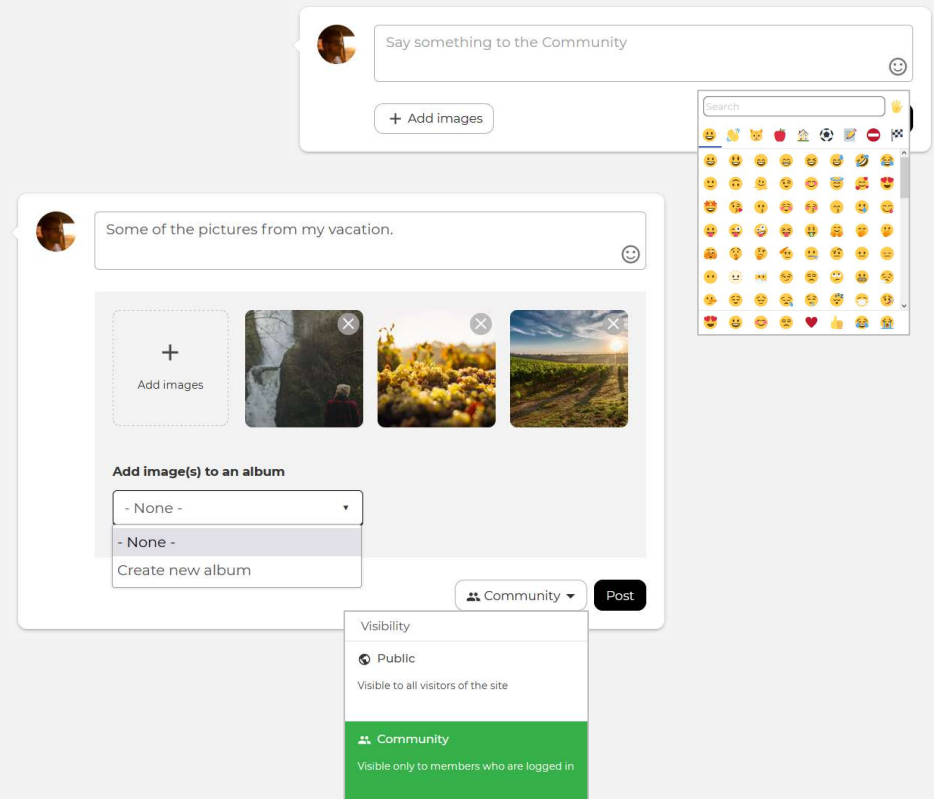

ROLES / ACCESS

Benefits of Convene include:

- **Anonymous users:** Visitors to your website that have not registered for an account. These users only have access to content that is set to be public.
- **Community members:** Users who have registered for an account and are logged in. These users have access to content that is set to be community members only and all public content.
- **GROUP / Nonmembers:** Users who have not joined the referenced group
- **GROUP / Members:** Users who have joined the referenced group
- **GROUP / Admin:** Users that have ownership of the group and full administrative control
- **GROUP / Manager:** Users who have been given administrative control within the group
- **ADMINISTRATOR / Community moderator:** Users who can access, edit, and delete all groups, group content, and community content regardless of visibility, membership, and privacy

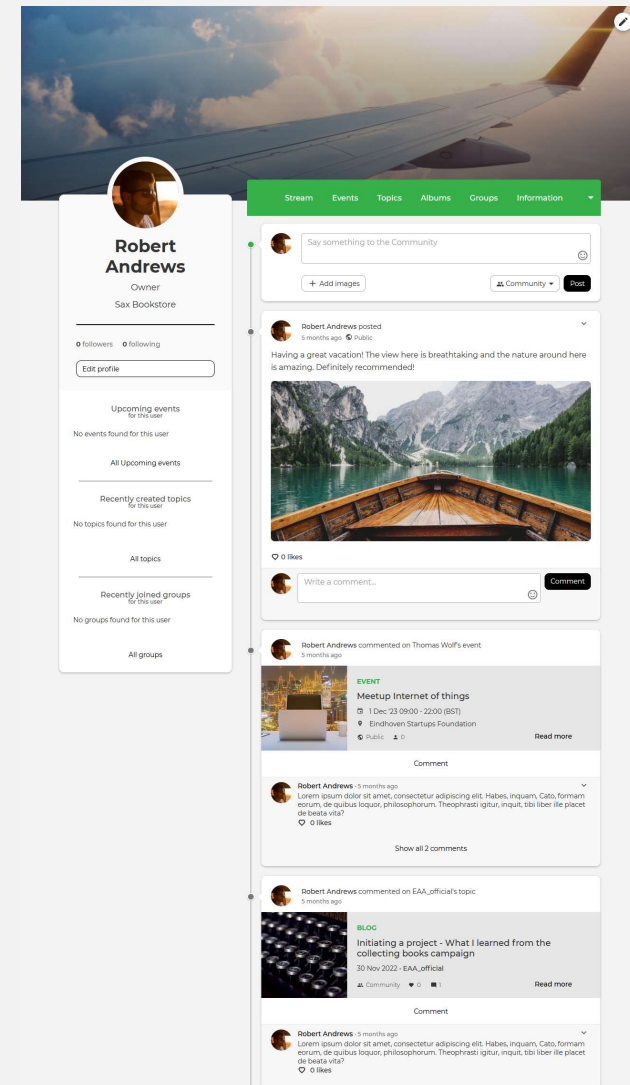


PROFILES

Convене ERP/DXP's registered users have a unique profile that tracks and organizes activity within the community. Their stream serves as a feed to share images/messages directly and view recent activity within the community, like posting comments.

Benefits of Convене include:

- Customizable banner and profile image
- Customizable name, username, and ability to control which you would like to display as your name on your profile.
- Information page with rich media support through a WYSIWYG editor.
- Customizable fields for additional information collected at registration such as phone number, address, etc..
- Viewing streams, events, topics, albums, and groups
- Creating events, topics, albums, and groups

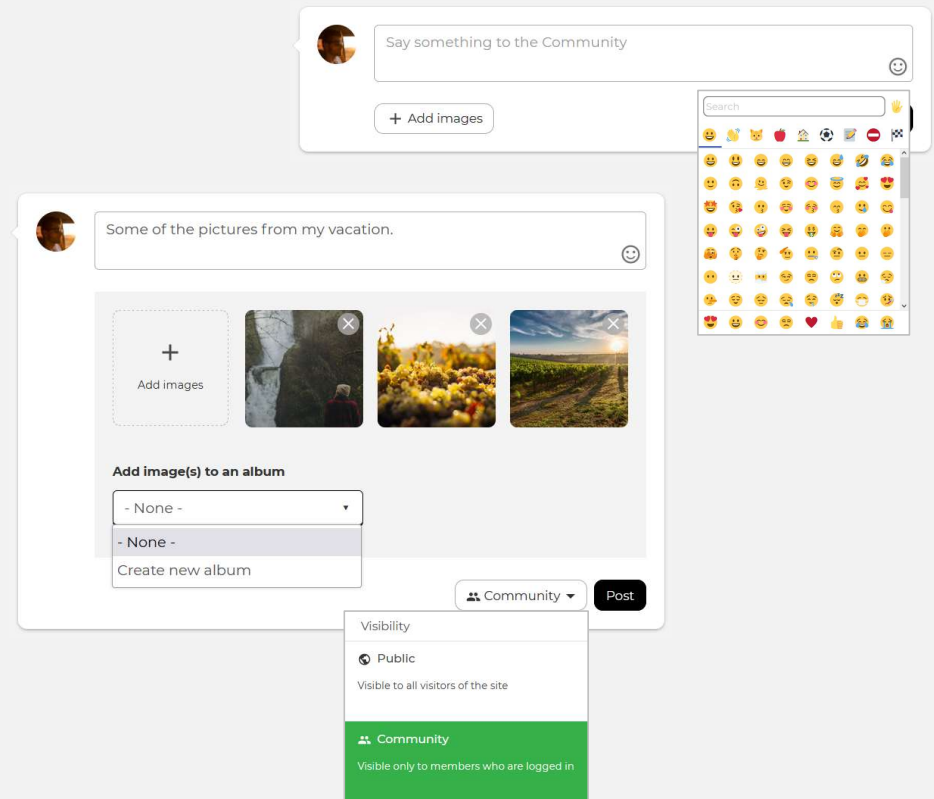


POSTING

Convене ERP/DXP's posting is the ability to create a unique piece of content, within the community, in contextual areas such as a profile stream, event, topic, album, or group.

Benefits of Convене include:

- Open text field for commenting with emoji support
- Ability to add an image or images
- When adding an image or images, the ability to add them to an album or create a new album
- Visibility settings that allow users to control the visibility of a post. In a group the posts visibility will default to the visibility set by the group owner.



COMMUNITY STREAM

Convене ERP/DXP's community stream is a feed of activity that is populated by content generated by the community and is set to be visible by the role interacting within.

Benefits of Convене include:

- If an anonymous user visits the stream, they will only see content that was set to be public
- If a community member visits the stream, they will see content that was set to be public, and content set to only be available to the community.
- If you are a part of a group, event, or topic, regardless of the way you joined it, any updates to those items will be posted to your stream as well.

EXPLORE

Convene ERP/DXP's Engage Community can be explored and discovered in several ways.

Benefits of Convene include:

- **Explore Groups** – Displays all the groups that are set to be visible at the level they are being viewed. If you are just visiting the site, you can see public groups. If you are logged in, you can see public and community groups. Etc.
- **Explore Events** - Displays all the events that are set to be visible at the level they are being viewed.
- **Explore Topics** - Displays all the topics that are set to be visible at the level they are being viewed.
- **Explore Members** - Displays all community members. By default, only registered community members can see this page.

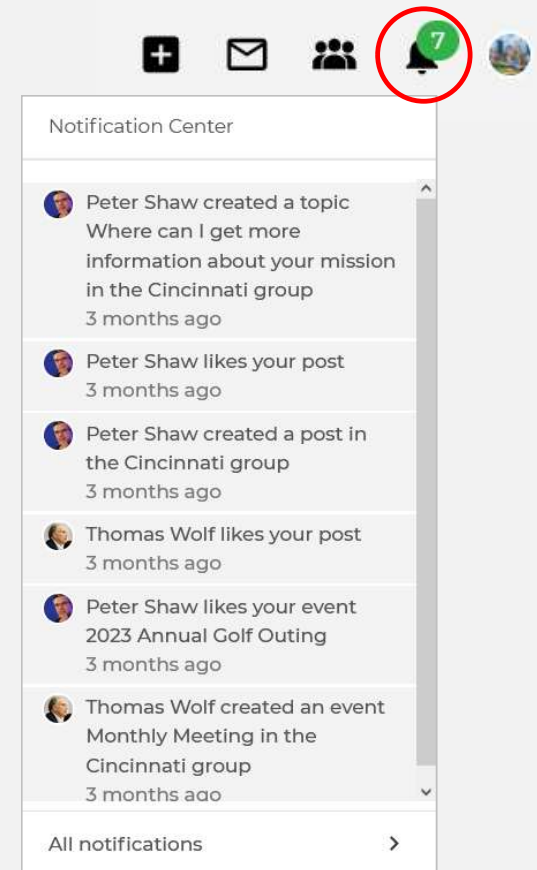

NOTIFICATIONS

Convене ERP/DXP's notifications are alerts that are generated from activity related to your profile, events, topics, followed content, and groups.

Benefits of Convене include:

- Notifications are user-friendly and allow registered community members to set their preferences.
- A system setting presents a notification under the bell icon with an expanded drop menu showing the most recent notifications.
- An email notification sent to the email address registered with the account provides convenience
- Notifications can be configured from each user's account preference settings, allowing the user to edit the frequency of email notifications. The presets of which are:
 - Never
 - Immediately
 - Daily
 - Weekly

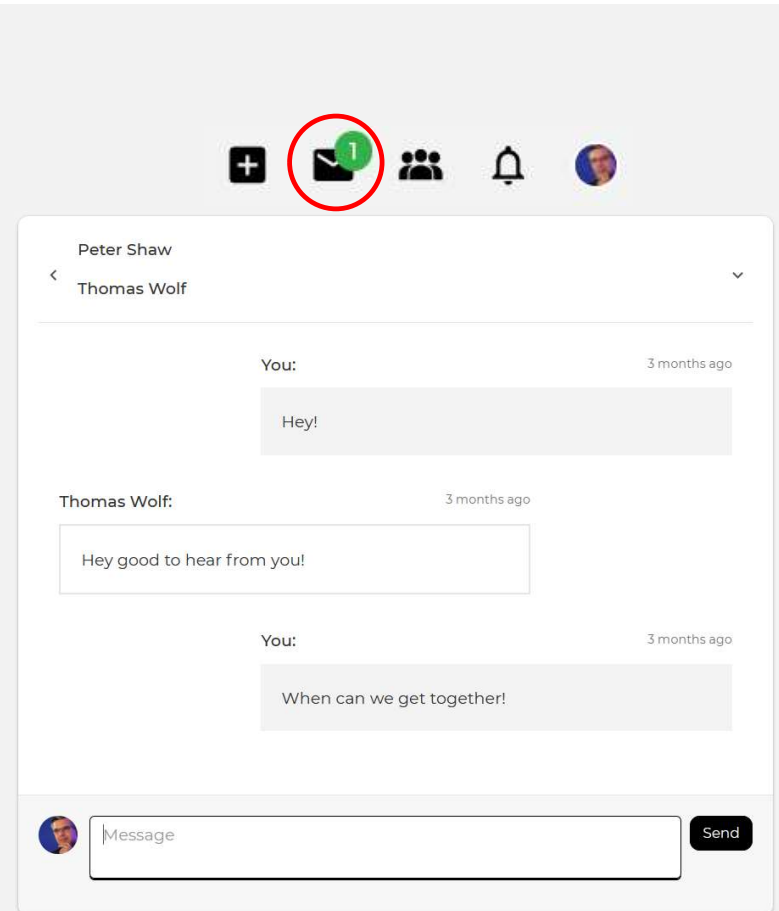


MESSAGES

Convене ERP/DXP's messaging feature is available to registered users and provides a way of creating private conversations with community members.

Benefits of Convене include:

- If a user profile is configured to be visible to community members, community members can type in user's name as a recipient of a message. If the user's name is found, a drop menu will populate with all available results based on the name or username written.
- When a user's message is sent, a dialog is created and a back-and-forth, text style, conversation is possible.
